BOARD SKILLS

- 5 4 3 2 1 How readable was the writing?
- 5 4 3 2 1 Did I stand sufficiently clear of the board for easy student viewing?
- 5 4 3 2 1 Did I make efficient use of the board space?

SPEAKING

- 5 4 3 2 1 How understandable was the speech?
